Operation Christmas Child

A small shoebox can have a big impact. What goes into the box is fun, but what comes out of it is eternal. Be a part of changing children's lives all over the world in Jesus' Name through the power of a simple gift with Operation Christmas Child.

What goes in a shoe box?

Delight a kid! Start with a medium to large item that will capture the child's attention the instant he or she opens the box.

Ideas include: Soccer ball with pump, Stuffed animal, Toys (puppets, trucks, etc.), Doll (baby, Barbie, etc.), Musical instrument, , Shoes, School Supplies (pens, pencils and, crayons, markers, notebooks, paper, solar calculators, coloring and picture books, etc.), Non-liquid Hygiene Items (toothbrushes, bar soap, combs, washcloths, etc.), Accessories (T-shirts, socks, hats, sunglasses, hair clips, jewelry, watches, flashlights (with extra batteries), etc.), and Crafts (Make your own items such as hair bows, finger puppets, and friendship bracelets).

Do Not Include: Used or damaged items; war-related items such as toy guns, knives, or military figures; chocolate or food; out-of-date candy; liquids or lotions; medications or vitamins; breakable items such as snow globes or glass containers; aerosol cans.

Please fill but do not overstuff the boxes.

When your box is ready, securely tape the label on the top of the box, use the furnished rubber band to hold it closed, and place \$7.00 or a check made out to Barb under the rubber band (Do not place the \$7.00 in a box). Boxes will need to be brought back to the church by Sunday, November 22. Please place all boxes under the table in the back of the church. Thank you for being a disciple to children round the world
