Weather Advisory

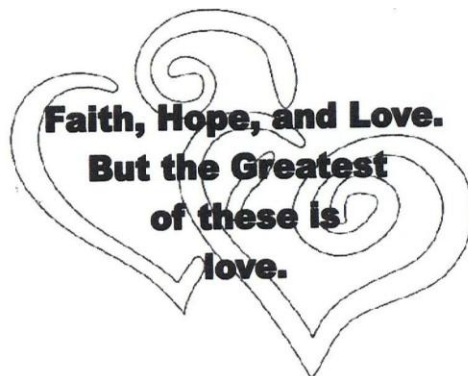
