Ladies Aid

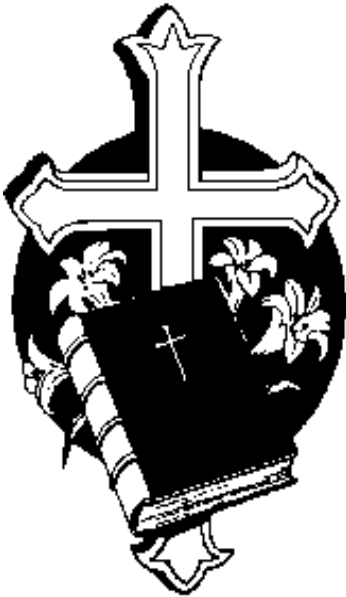
St. Paul's next Ladies' Aid meeting will be this Tuesday, March 18 at 7:00 pm in St. Paul's Parish Hall.
