### *Immanuel Lutheran Church Tours*

Join us for a day in St. Louis on April 20, 2017. Our first stop will be at the Missouri Botanical Garden, also known as Shaw's Garden, named for the founder and philanthropist, Henry Shaw. It was founded in 1859 and is one of the oldest botanical garden institutions in the United States. Here you will be treated to a narrated tram ride over part of the 79 acres of horticultural displays.

We will leave Shaw's Garden for downtown St. Louis where we will enjoy a delicious lunch at the Old Spaghetti Factory restaurant. This restaurant offers a unique family friendly dining experience and delicious Italian food.

After lunch, we are off to visit Historic Trinity Church, which was founded in 1839 by Saxon immigrants who settled in St. Louis and in small communities in Perry County. Today, the church is a diverse, caring and welcoming Christian community of over 700 persons, located adjacent to downtown St. Louis and serving the entire metro area.

Our last stop will be the Old Courthouse National Historic Site which has been the scene of many important events in St. Louis and nationally. It is one of the city's architectural landmarks and was the site of 2 trials where Dred Scott and his wife sued for their freedom and where suffragist Virginia Minor sued for the right to vote in 1872.

The price of \$89.00 includes transportation, lunch, all activities, taxes, and gratuities. We will leave from Immanuel's parking lot at 7:00 am and return around 6:00 pm.
