### ***The Meaning of "Quasimodo Geniti"***

The second Sunday of Easter is traditionally known as Quasimodo Geniti, which are the first Latin words [*quasi modo geniti infantes* ("like newborn infants")] of the Historic Introit assigned to this Sunday from First Peter two and the eighty-first psalm, wherein we are urged to sing praise to God who alone, by the spiritual food of his Word, is our strength and salvation.

(Note: The hunchback in Victor Hugo's famous novel was supposed to have been abandoned as an infant at Notre Dame on this day in the church's liturgical year, hence his name "Quasi Modo".)
