"Helping People Touch the Promises of Jesus"

In October 2011, Lutheran Braille Work Center #165 moved from Immanuel Lutheran Church in West Point to Chester under the sponsorship of St. John Lutheran Church. The work force has increased from four to eight groups of men and women who regularly work once a month. These workers are members of six local Lutheran congregations as well as several area non-Lutheran churches. In that time, this center's mailing quota has more than doubled, having mailed 885 books to 27 different states and 14 countries, including many third world countries. Braille centers throughout North America currently produce 300,000 volumes per year in 30 different languages. This is a wonderful opportunity for a local mission that touches the worldwide mission fields.

Just as everyone is not able to work in foreign fields, everyone is not able to work at this nearby location. However, we do ask that you prayerfully consider financially supporting this mission. Books are mailed free of charge, and our workspace is rent free, but currently the cost of our supplies and utilities are not being covered by the donations designated for our work center. Included in the bulletin is a donation in three ways: by mailing the enclosed envelope as it is addressed, dropping it in your collection plate, or taking it to your church office. Checks may be made payable to "Lutheran Braille Workers". Contributions given through your church will be recorded on your annual contribution statements. Work centers are considered self-supporting and ours will be closed if we are unable to obtain the necessary funding.

On April 20 & 21, Pastor Dave Andrus, Administrator of Christian Outreach of the newly unified Lutheran Blind Mission and Lutheran Braille Workers, Inc. of Yucaipa, CA, will be speaking at all three services and the Bible class at St. John in Chester. Everyone is invited to participate in this Braille Awareness opportunity. Services are held on Saturday at 6:30 pm and Sunday at 7:45 and 10:00 am. Bible Class is held in the church at 9:00 am between services. For more information on Pastor Andrus, watch for an upcoming article in our local newspapers.
