The Meaning of "Cantate"

The fifth Sunday of Easter is traditionally known as Cantate, which is the first Latin word [*Cantate Domino Canticum novum...* ("Sing to the LORD a new song")] of the Historic Introit assigned to this Sunday from the ninety-eighth psalm, which the Church sings in thanksgiving for redemption.
