Donations of gently used furniture are also still appreciated. If you have pieces that you would like to donate, please see Dan or Joyce.

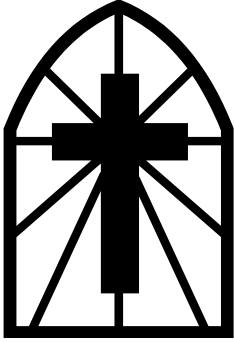
### *Bald Knob Cross*

### *Why take a VBS bus to the zoo?*

It will be a complete day of Vacation Bible School on wheels. We will leave St. Paul Church at 8:45 am singing "Rise and Shine", followed by the Bible stories of Noah and the Great Flood. A real-life feel for the dimensions of the ark will be done, the youth aboard will help fill the ark with animals, and then the flood will begin. The sound of a real flood will be pantomimed by the passengers aboard the bus—from sprinkle drops to downpour, with thunder and lightning! The enormous passage of days onboard the ark will be experienced with the animals needing fed and the storm roaring and then the winds drying the land. These "days" will be passed by making crafts, playing games, eating a snack, and singing. Finally our hope of dry land will be the sending out of the raven and the dove near the sighting of the St. Louis Arch. At this time the rainbow will appear on the bus and God's promise to all will be explained. Our dry land will be the zoo, where we can all experience the beautiful animals that God saved on the ark.
