Difficulty in hearing the service?

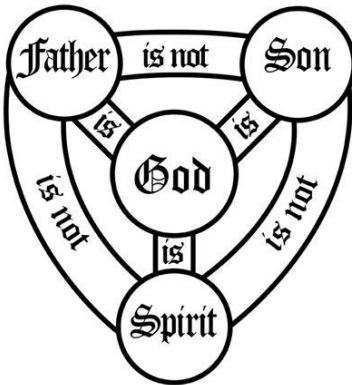
