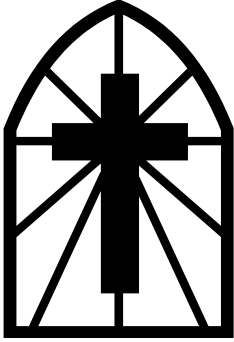
Thrivent
