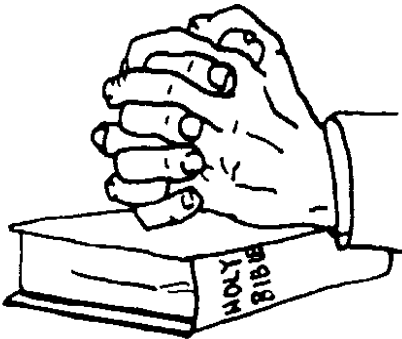
Men's & Ladies' Bible Study - 9:30 am at the Manor at Craig Farm
