

You can save additional time, by also visiting www.redcrossblood.org/RapidPass to complete your pre-reading and donation questions online and print out your Rapid Pass to bring with you. This can also be emailed to your smart phone for easy access. It is suggested to increase the probability of your donation being accepted that you limit your intake of tea and increase your consumption of iron rich foods the week prior to the drive.
