Concordia Summer Workshops

Concordia Seminary announces two summer workshops in July on the St Louis campus. Faith and Writing which will explore and experiment with all kinds of creative writing – from starting a blog, to creating a sermon or devotion, to all the forms of “traditional” creative writing to everything in between. Concordia Presents "Lutheran as Pastoral Theologian"

Concordia Seminary will host its summer Lay Bible Institute from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, Aug. 10 in Sieck Hall 202 on the Seminary campus. "Luther as Pastoral Theologian" will be presented by Dr. Erik Herrmann, associate professor of historical theology at Concordia Seminary.

Martin Luther was a complex figure — a professor, a theologian, a monk, a polemicist, a reformer. But he was also a pastor. In fact, for Luther being a pastor was his most important and comprehensive role. What if one looked at Luther and the entire Lutheran Reformation as a rediscovery and revitalization of pastoral care? In this course, we will look at Martin Luther's life and theology afresh from the perspective of his work as pastor. We will read together some of his letters, sermons, and other catechetical and devotional writings that touch on such pastoral themes as prayer, consolation, dying, doubt, music, art, and humor.
