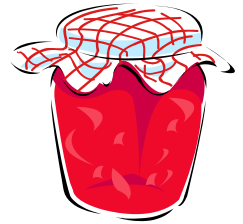

COS Graduates College and Career Ready: *Christ Our Savior* graduates continue to outpace their peers in Illinois on the ACT exam measuring college and career readiness. The graduates of 2013 scored three points better than the average Senior in the state of Illinois. This has been a continuous trend for over five years. The students specifically shined in Mathematics, scoring six points higher than the state average.
