Western Egyptian EOC Offers Utility Bill Pay Assistance

On September 5, residents in Jackson, Monroe, Perry, and Randolph Counties will be able to make an appointment for an application for a home energy grant through the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP). The LIHEAP is designed to help low income eligible households pay for their upcoming winter energy services and reduce their energy burden.

County Outreach Offices are staffed for LIHEAP assistance Monday through Friday from 8:00 - 4:30. An outreach office is located in each of the following counties: Jackson County in Murphysboro (684-3341), Randolph County in Sparta (443-5231), Perry County in DuQuoin (542-4656) and Monroe in Waterloo (939-8751).
