### **Thank You**





Questions may have arisen as to who may attend this camp. What do we mean by “fathers and sons”? Great question! We encourage all men to attend who have an interest in biblical masculinity, and what it means for them and their families as a whole, even if they are not able to attend with a son. We have registering, a grandfather with his son and grandson. We have men registering with sons of various ages from 12 years old to 25 years old. A father is a father always to his sons, and is charged to teach the faith to

them all- “that you may fear the Lord your God, you and your son and your son’s son.” (Duet 6:2)

How about young fathers with sons too young to attend but want to get a jump on biblical manhood for teaching and modeling it? YES! We would like to hear from them too. The minimum age limit of 7 years old is a guideline in which you think your son will be able to sit next to you in the presentations and to engage in the various activities being planned. The teachings are for both fathers and sons to hear and learn and do together.
